Camp Philosophy:

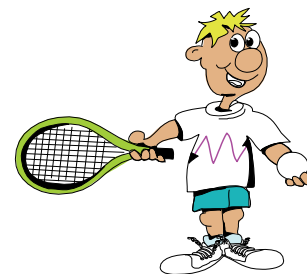
Tennis is a lifetime sport. We focus on teaching the skills necessary for enjoyment of the game on both a competitive and recreational level.
