FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC RECRUITMENT INFORMATION

2010 Salary: \$5,448-6,622/month plus excellent benefits

The City of Tumwater maintains a continuous recruitment for the position of Firefighter/Paramedic. Minimum qualifications include:

- **Current Paramedic Certification:** Must possess **either** 1) Washington State, or 2) state of residence **and** current **or** former National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians-Paramedics (NREMT-P) certification.
- Must be approved and deemed eligible for employment by the Medical Program Director of Thurston County Medic One as a paramedic in Thurston County at the time of application.

Additional minimum qualifications are listed in the recruitment announcement. Qualified candidates should contact Thurston County Medic One at (360) 704-2780.

Thurston County Medic One will conduct firefighter/paramedic examinations as needed. Once an applicant successfully passes the Medic One process, the City of Tumwater will be informed of the name of the applicant. The City of Tumwater will then communicate with the applicant. To be placed on the City of Tumwater's eligibility list for Firefighter/Paramedic the applicant will have to pay a \$20 application fee and pass a written examination. The names of successful applicants will then be proposed to the Tumwater Civil Service Commission for placement on the eligibility list according to their written score.

The eligibility list is a continuous list, that is, the list itself never expires, names on the list do. Candidate scores are valid for one year on this list.

Firefighter/Paramedics who are currently employed by another Thurston County Medic One agency are also eligible to apply for a transfer to Tumwater through this process. Lateral applicants should contact Debbie Lund, City of Tumwater human resources, at 360-754-4122 or dlund@ci.tumwater.wa.us.
