

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

TO THE CITY OF TUMWATER, WASHINGTON

Requires 60% participation based on assessed value of all properties within proposed annexation area.

TO THE HONORABLE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUMWATER, WASHINGTON, City of Tumwater, 555 Israel Road S. W., Tumwater WA 98501:

We, the undersigned, being the owners of not less than sixty percent (60%) in value, of the real property herein described, do hereby petition that such territory be annexed to and made a part of the City of Tumwater.*

The territory proposed to be annexed is within Thurston County, Washington. A description of the property and a map which outlines the boundaries of the property as more particularly described in Exhibit A is attached hereto.

The City Council of the City of Tumwater met with the initiating parties at a Council meeting on _____, _____ and did determine that the City would accept the proposed annexation.

At said meeting, the City Council did also determine that:

It would require the simultaneous adoption of a comprehensive plan for the area to be annexed; and

It would require the assumption of existing City indebtedness by the area to be annexed,

as disclosed by the minute entry regarding the same in the minutes of said Council meeting.

This page is one of a number of pages forming one petition seeking the annexation of territory to the City of Tumwater, Washington, as above stated, and may be filed with other pages containing additional signatures.

WARNING

Every person who signs this petition with any other than his or her true name, or who knowingly signs more than one of these petitions, or signs a petition seeking an election when he or she is not a legal voter, or signs a petition when he or she is otherwise not qualified to sign, or who makes herein any false statement, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Any officer of a corporation owning land within the area involved, who is duly authorized to execute deeds or encumbrances on behalf of the corporation, may sign under oath on behalf of such corporation. If an officer signs the petition, he or she must attach a certified excerpt from the bylaws of such corporation showing such authority and attach an affidavit stating that he or she is duly authorized to sign the petition on behalf of such corporation. Names of the petitioners should be in identical form as the same appear of record in the chain of title to the real estate. Both husbands and wives must sign.
