LITTLEROCK ROAD CLOSURE -- PAVING Wednesday, November 4, 2009

Wednesday, November 4th, is predicted to be sunny and mild. In order to take full advantage of this weather opportunity, the City of Tumwater will be closing Littlerock Road between Israel Road and Tumwater Boulevard beginning at 7:00 AM to allow the contractor to place the final lift of asphalt through this section of the roadway. In the late afternoon, it is anticipated that the intersection of Israel Road will be closed to complete paving in the roundabout.

Depending on the progress of the work and weather conditions, paving work may extend into Thursday, November 5th as well.

The City is asking for the cooperation of the travelling public by requesting that they avoid the Littlerock Road corridor between Israel Road and Tumwater Boulevard and use alternate routes. Motorists will be detoured via Linderson Way and Tumwater Boulevard/Israel Road. Although the roundabouts at Israel Road and Tumwater Boulevard will be open for most of the day, motorists will encounter significant delays and are strongly advised to use alternate routes and avoid the construction area if at all possible. During the afternoon closure of the Israel Road intersection, traffic will be stopped and redirected at Odegard Road.
