## NORTH STREET ROAD CLOSURE

Friday & Saturday, December 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup>

***North Street will be closed to through traffic beginning Friday, December 4<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM and continuing through 12:00 Noon, Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup>.*** The closure will be in effect at the intersection of Cleveland Avenue/Custer Way/North Street. Local traffic will be able to access North Street from all other available routes.

Traffic control will be in place for traffic on Cleveland Avenue and Custer Way. This will include a reduced number of lanes and one-way traffic under flagger control. Traffic delays through the intersection should be expected and the use of alternate routes is recommended.

The Friday/Saturday closure is necessary in order to perform repairs on the sanitary sewer line serving the neighborhoods adjacent to North Street. The work will be limited to the immediate vicinity of the Cleveland Avenue/Custer Way/North Street intersection and is being performed during night time hours to avoid disruption to peak hour traffic volumes.

Motorists are advised to use alternate routes via Carlyon Avenue, Cleveland Avenue or Henderson Boulevard.
