CONFERENCES & TRAINING

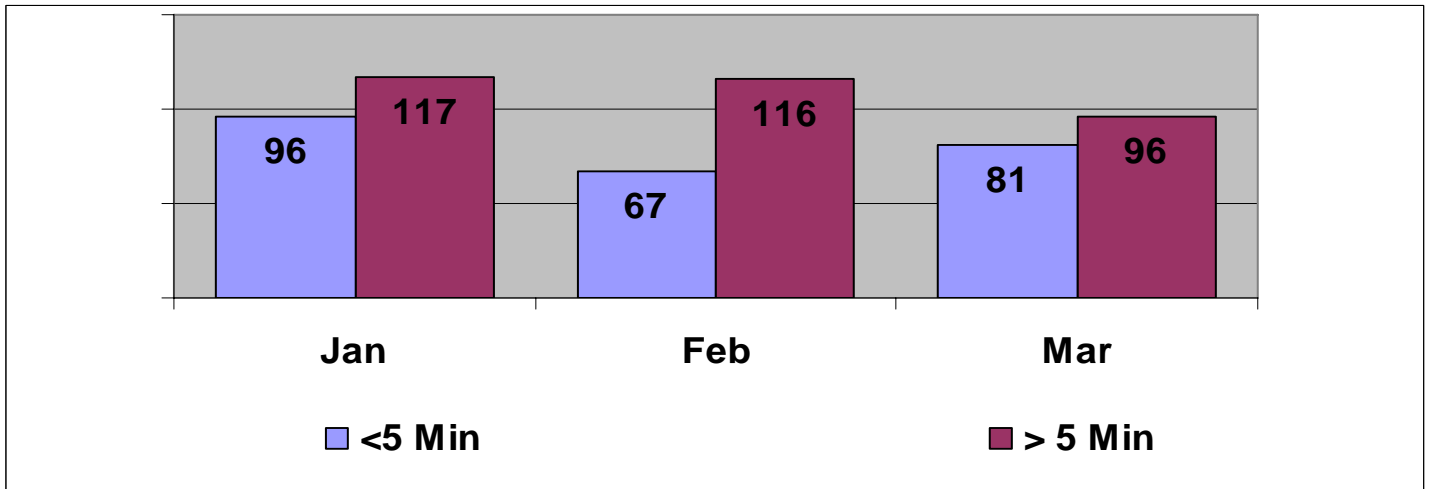

- 3/24-25 PM Darlene Raffelson was an instructor at the North Bend Fire Academy for the Firefighter One Module/Search & Rescue Course.



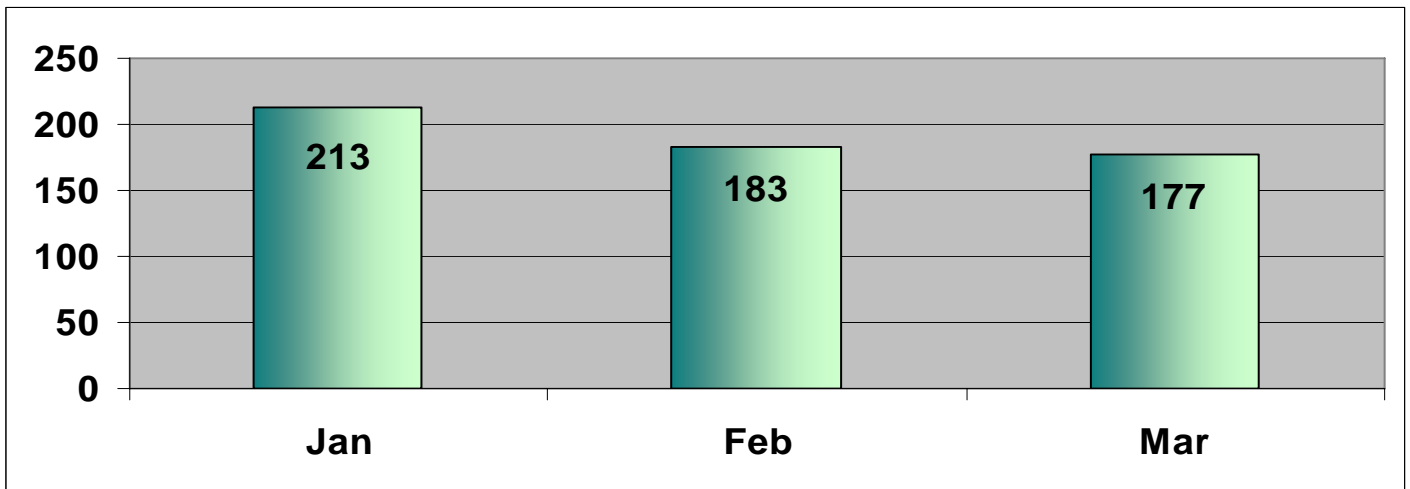

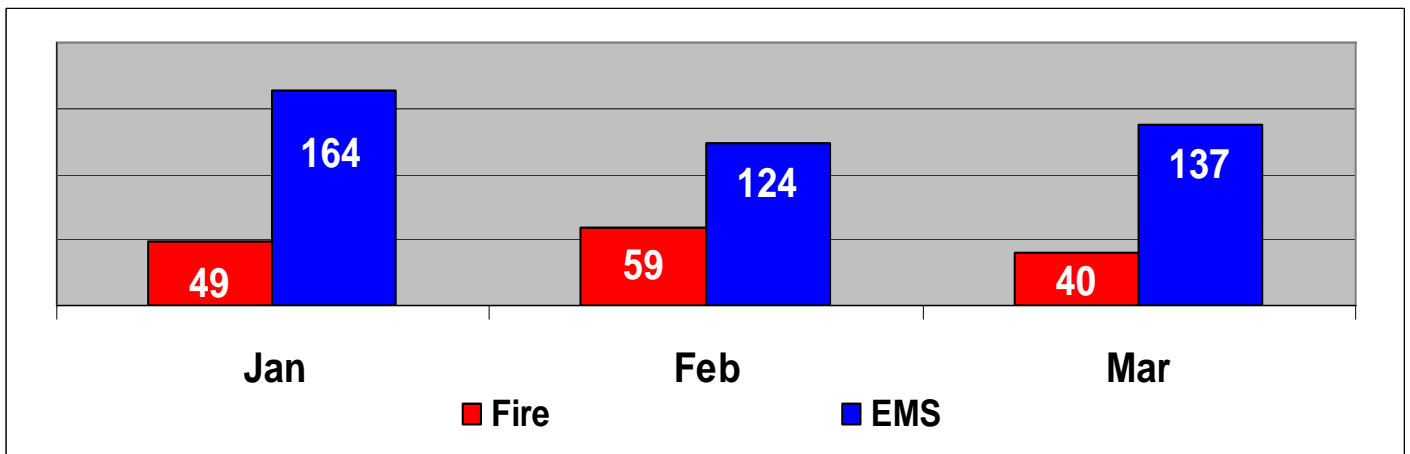
Fire & BLS Response Averages



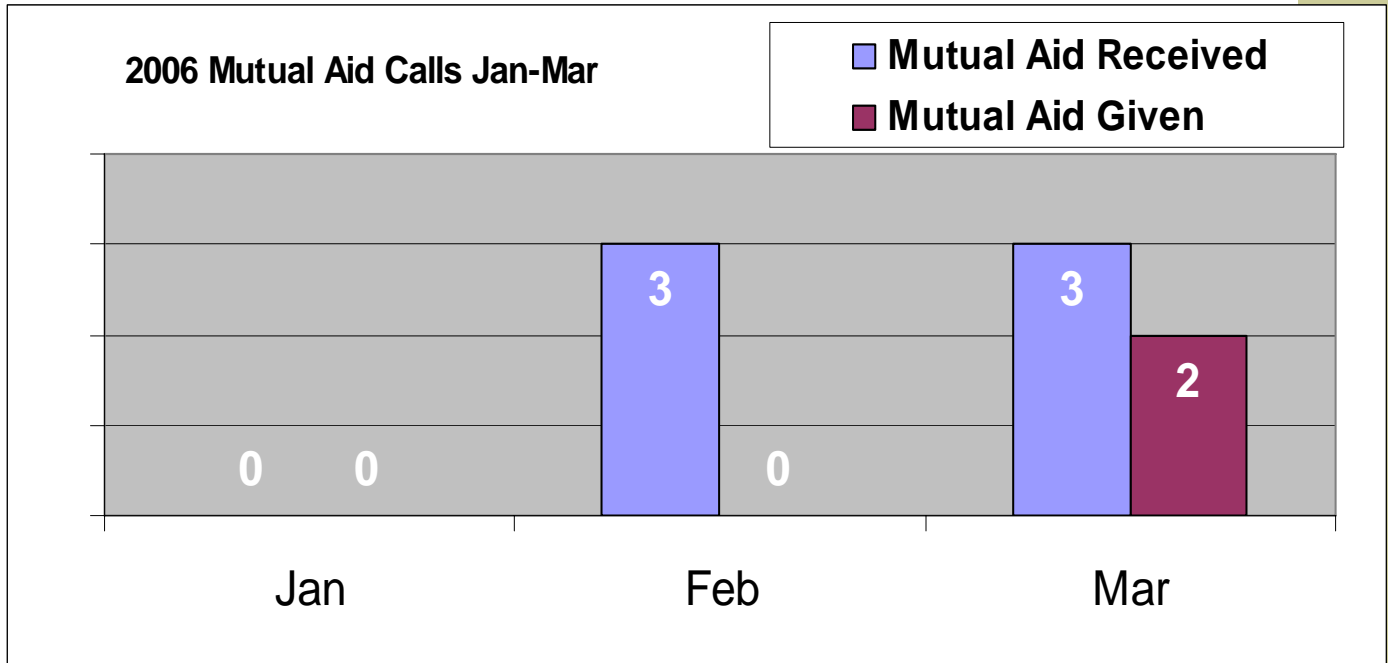
Engine Call Volume



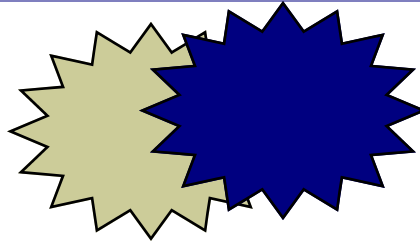
Fire vs BLS
