

## CHAPTER 3 ERRATA

This chapter identifies corrections to the Supplemental Draft EIS (SDEIS), including text changes and clarifications, based on comments received on the SDEIS and other updated information.

### Site Area – Proposed Action

An error was made in the SDEIS regarding the site area under the Proposed Action. The site area was erroneously stated as 21.5 acres. The correct area is 20.5 acres. This corrected area is represented in this SFEIS, and any impact analysis where this would be important (i.e. the tree retention calculations) have been updated.

### Landscaping Regulations – Proposed Action & Alternative 1

An error was made in the SDEIS regarding the landscaping regulations in TMC 18.47. The SDEIS erroneously indicated that, per TMC 18.47, an additional 260 trees would be planted onsite under the Proposed Action and 208 trees would be planted onsite under Alternative 1, beyond those required to satisfy the tree replacement requirements in TMC 16.08.070. The correct interpretation of the landscaping regulations is represented in this SFEIS, where it is indicated that the trees proposed to be replanted onsite per TMC 16.08.070 would also meet the tree requirements in TMC 18.47.

### Public Services

SDEIS Section 3.12.1, first paragraph, third line under “Tumwater Fire Department”, “and by contract ALS ESM”, is hereby deleted. The sentence now reads as follows:

“The City of Tumwater Fire Department provides fire protection, basic life support (BLS) emergency medical service (EMS) and advanced life support (ALS) EMS to a service area that corresponds to the City of Tumwater jurisdictional boundaries, and by contract service to Thurston County Fire Protection District #15, a 1.5-square mile area.”

SDEIS Section 3.12.1, third paragraph, third line under “Tumwater Fire Department”, the following sentence is hereby deleted, because the northend station did not open in 2006:

“This station is only currently staffed when personnel are available, which is about 50 percent of the time.”
