Barnes Lake Condo's – Lake Park Drive

Committee member Tom Sparks provided an overview of the site and described both efforts undertaken by the Condo Owners Association (COA) and the LMD. In response to beaver activity on the site, the COA removed some damaged trees and “caged” others to protect them.





Loft Residence – Lake Park Drive

Committee member Judith Loft provided an overview of the site and detailed their efforts and challenges to remove floating mats that migrate toward their property during wind events.



Weaver Residence – Lake Terrace Drive

Committee member Rusty Weaver described his efforts to reduce impacts from floating mats along their shoreline, and pointed out an animal den right on the bank of the lake.





Waddington Residence – Linwood Avenue

The Waddington’s were unable to join the tour; however, they requested the LMD Committee visit their site to consider options for floating mat removal.

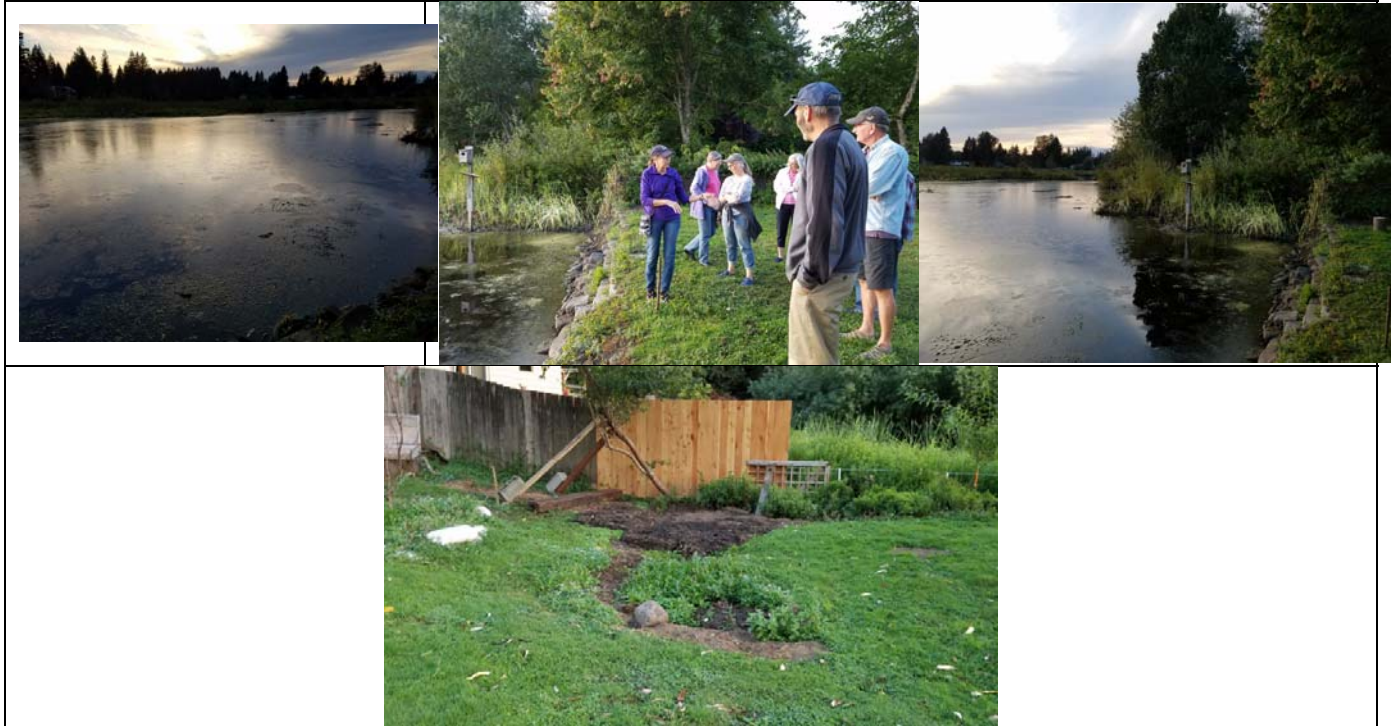


McCafferty Residence – Daisy Lane

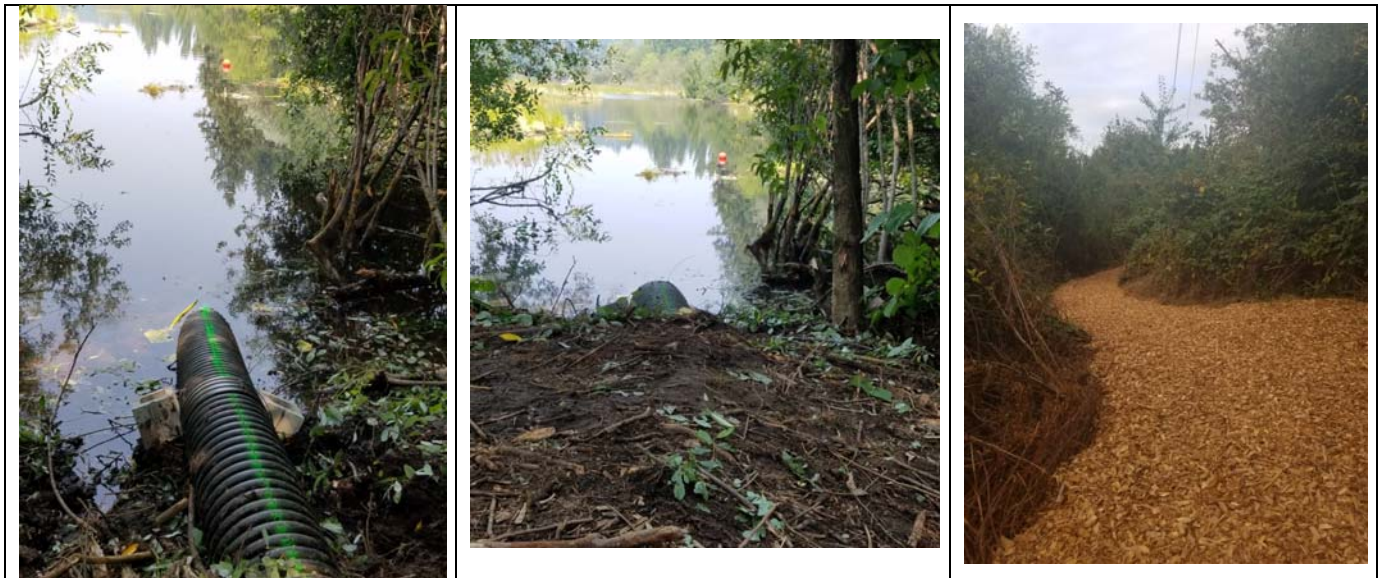
Peterson Residence – Lark Street
